Rules and Regulations

Entrant agrees that the time, manner, and method of judging shall be solely within the discretion of the Miss Tabouleh Pageant Board, and that the decision of the Judges will be final.

A Contestant must be legally single and never have been married.

A Contestant must be a female, no older than 18. Age eligibility is between 5 and 18 years old.

A Contestant must display talent in a no more than ***4-minute talent routine***. The Contestant may accompany herself or have recorded accompaniment. No other person shall accompany a Contestant. This talent performance may be singing, dancing, playing a musical instrument, dramatic reading, art display, etc., or she may give a maximum ***4-minute*** speech.

The Miss Tabouleh Festival Pageant Board of Directors is the final authority in all matters regarding the competition and conduct of the competition. The Candidate agrees to abide by all decisions made by the Board.

NOTE: All Candidates and/or parents of Candidates are responsible for a wardrobe consisting of Personal Introduction Wear, Evening Wear, Talent Wear, Casual Wear, shoes and accessories. Note: Personal Introduction and Casual wear outfit may be the same outfit if Contestant so chooses. A wardrobe change in between Introduction and Casual Wear modeling is allowed but not required.

Areas of Competition/Scoring for the 2022 Miss Tabouleh Pageant

- Personal Introduction
- Casual Wear
- Talent
- Evening Wear
- On-Stage Question

*Each Candidate will receive a score of 1-10 in every competition category.

Personal Introduction

- ❖ Each contestant will briefly introduce herself on stage to the audience and judges at the start of the competition.
- ❖ Personal introductions should last no longer than 30 seconds.
- ❖ Introductions should include your name, age, school, and contestant number.
- ❖ Introductions may also include hobbies, accomplishments, life goals/aspirations or fun facts about yourself.

Casual Wear

- ❖ Each contestant will model an outfit of her choice in a fun, casual, high energy portion of the competition.
- ❖ The outfit of choice may be casual everyday wear, dressy or athletic. Any color, solid or print.

Talent

- ❖ Any talent may be performed (i.e. vocal, dancing, instrumental, monologue, magic, gymnastics, etc.)
- ❖ MAXIMUM time limit is **4 minutes**.
- ❖ Background music must be turned in on CD **or** sent via email in MP3 format to smith.chelsea@me.com, **or** you may accompany yourself with a musical instrument. No one else may accompany you live.

Evening Wear

- ❖ Formal gowns (long or short) may be worn.
- ❖ Selection Panel will be instructed to consider how you look and move in the dress – not the dress itself.

On-Stage Question

- ❖ Each contestant will be asked one topically relevant on-stage question. Their presentation and answer will be scored.
- ❖ Questions for Junior and Miss contestants may be about current events, personal ideas and views, etc.
- ❖ Questions will be randomly selected out of a container by each contestant and read aloud by the emcee.
- ❖ Questions will be of equal difficulty for each age group and will not be made available for contestants to read prior to the competition.
- ❖ Contestants should listen carefully to the question being asked.
- ❖ When answering, contestants should speak clearly, be concise and to the point.

Selection Panel (Judges)

- ❖ The Selection Panel will consist of 3 to 5 people.
- ❖ Judges will be from out of town; of various ages and professional backgrounds.
- ❖ Neither Parents nor Contestants will be permitted to communicate with Judges before or during the competition.
